



Professional Masters of Education

In the Professional Masters of Education programme, *school placement* occurs over two years and positions the classroom and school as places to learn *to* teach and to learn *about* teaching. A School Placement is scheduled in each semester of Year 1 as outlined below.

Year 1 School Placements

School Placement 1: November - December 2017

- Partnered placement (two students per class) in Middle classes (1st – 4th)
- November 20th – December 1st
(School visit November 13th)
- Focus of placement: *beginning to teach* – gradual increase in teaching workload, each student will teach 2/3 lessons per day
- Students teach a range of curriculum areas
- College tutor to visit and assess students on placement (pass/fail module)
- Class teacher as informal mentor and provides verbal advice/feedback to students

Professional Placement 2: Monday April 9th - Friday May 18th, 2018

- Six week placement
- The student is based in a school of his/her choice and in a class level between 1st and 6th
- It is a non-partnered placement
- The placement combines whole class teaching of the selected class for three weeks as well as structured participation in school-wide teaching and learning initiative.

- **Teaching schedule**

Week 1 & 2: Observing, assisting and independent preparation

Week 3 – 5: Teaching selected class and participation in whole-school initiatives

Week 6: Participation in whole-school work including participation in initiatives such as Aistear, Team Teaching etc.

- **Teaching focus**

Students will teach all areas of the curriculum (topics to be agreed with the teacher)

- **Co-operating teacher's role**

Facilitating student's observation and teaching and providing informal non-evaluative feedback.
Guidance to be provided to all co-operating teachers.

- **College tutor** to visit and assess students on placement (Graded A – F)
