The purpose of the conference is to reflect on the peculiarity of the teachings of Thomas of Aquinas and their relevance to the 21st century scholars, as well as to the society of today. The event will be part of the ICUSTA Biennial Assembly in 2015 to be held in Maputo; it will also be part of the University of St. Thomas of Mozambique 10th anniversary.
