

## 1. Fulbright Student Awards

Grants in all disciplines, except clinical medical studies, for Irish citizens or EU citizens resident in the Republic of Ireland for the past 3 years to complete postgraduate research or study for a min. period of 4 months. Applicants can do a full PhD or Masters in the US or a portion of an ongoing Irish postgraduate degree. Funding is for a max. 1 year.

## 2. Fulbright Scholar Awards

Grants in all disciplines, except clinical medical studies, for Irish citizens or E.U. citizens resident in the Republic of Ireland for 3 or more years to complete postdoctoral or professional research or lecturing in the United States. These awards are also open to non-academics with five or more years experience in their field. The minimum grant period is three months and the maximum is one year.

## 3. Fulbright TechImpact Scholar Awards

Grants designed to respond to the potential and pace of ICT and to explore how technology can contribute to a larger social value. The awards are for Irish citizens or E.U. citizens resident in the Republic of Ireland for three or more years to complete postdoctoral or professional non-commercial based research on the impact and application of ICT across all disciplines for periods of two weeks to three months. Preference will be given to candidates who have received their PhD since 2011 and candidates in the areas of education, mobile technology and digital arts, humanities, and culture.

## 4. Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistantship Awards

The Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistantship (FLTA) Awards are grants for Irish citizens or E.U. citizens resident in the Republic of Ireland for three or more years with fluent Irish to teach Irish at a U.S. college in over the course of ten months in the United States.
