Professor Liam Gearon is only the 2nd person in the history of the University of Oxford to hold the University Lectureship in Religious Education, in association with a Senior Research Fellowship at Harris Manchester College, Oxford. He also holds the posts of Adjunct Professor at the Australian Catholic University; and Conjoint Professor in Humanities Research Institute, Newcastle University, Australia. He is a recognised expert in the area of human rights and was invited to speak on religion, human rights and education by UNESCO at the Nobel Institute, Norway. In 2006, he was one of only ten international experts invited worldwide to contribute to a working consultation which produced the official *UNESCO Guidelines on Intercultural Education* (UNESCO, Paris 2006).
