#### **Metrics for Your CV or Promotion Portfolio – Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2pm-4pm**

This workshop will show you how to gather a number of metrics for your promotion portfolio or CV including:

- Numbers of Web of Science (ISI) publications
- H-index calculated using Web of Science, Scopus & Google Scholar/Publish or Perish
- Journal Impact Factors and Web of Science (ISI) journal rankings
- SCImago Journal Rank
- Alternative journal ranking schemes
- Download statistics
- Altmetrics

#### **Finding Research Information & Keeping Up-To-Date – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> April, 10am-12pm**

This workshop will show you how to:

- Formulate an effective search strategy to find high quality information relevant to your research area
- Construct search statements and perform precise searches in Web of Science and Scopus using Boolean operators, truncation, wildcards and proximity operators
- Keep up-to-date with the latest research in your field using technologies such as saved searches, email alerts and RSS feeds.

#### **Altmetrics – Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> April, 1pm-2pm**

This workshop will:

- Explain what altmetrics are and how they can be useful in showing the impact of your publications
- Show you how to use Altmetric for Institutions to track and evaluate the online dissemination and impact of your authored research
- Demonstrate how Altmetric for Institutions can assist in identifying potential collaborators by identifying international researchers who are talking about your research.

#### **Getting Published & Maximising your Research Impact – Friday 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2pm-4pm**

This workshop will show you tools and techniques to aid you in the following topics:

- Publishing in high impact journals (e.g. using Journal Citation Reports)
- Ensuring your research is easily identifiable (e.g. using ORCID and Google Scholar Profiles)
- Increasing the visibility of your research outputs (e.g. using Open Access and ULIR)
- Communicating & promoting your research (e.g. using Twitter and blogs)
- Measuring the impact of your research (e.g. using the h-index and Altmetrics)
