

The Family, School, Community Educational Partnership Project

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The *Family, School, Community Educational Partnership* (FSCEP) project was a four-year action research project. FSCEP worked closely with the Home-School-Community Liaison Scheme to develop and promote educational partnerships within schools and communities. Much emphasis was placed on creating positive contexts for education partners to work together in collaborative ways and in enabling people to engage with the partnership process. The five project schools (located in RAPID and CLÁR areas) identified the focus of activities as literacy, numeracy, arts and sports and programmes were designed and implemented collaboratively with staff and parents in classroom and community settings.
